NanotechItaly2015: program published

More than 100 acknowledged speakers during the 3-day Conference on Nanotechnologies and Key Enabling Tech in Bologna (November 25-27, 2015)

(Rome, October, 28, 2015) The full program of NanotechItaly 2015 is now available. The leading International Conference on nanotechnologies and KETs will take place for the first time in Bologna, with talks from renewed representatives from industry and research ([download the program](#)).

As in previous editions, the Conference will open with three introductory plenary lectures, this year delivered by **Christos Tokamanis**, Head of the Unit “Nanoscience and Nanotechnologies”, DG Research, EU Commission, **Roberto Cingolani**, Scientific Director, Italian Institute of Technology, and **Luigi Colombo**, TI Analog Technology Fellow, Research Strategy & Consortia, Texas Instruments Inc. (US).

During the 3- day event there will be **11** sessions, **6** workshops, involving more than **115** speakers, with more than **50** hours of contributions, some **100** posters, **15** selected business exhibitors, a dedicated brokerage event.

The aim is to showcase how nanotechnologies and the other Key Enabling Technologies¹ can contribute to innovation and to spotlight applications oriented research in fields crucial for growth and wellbeing.

Healthcare and medical devices, smart manufacturing and robotics, materials and graphene based innovation, bio-based and bio-inspired tech, as well as key sectors for the Made in Italy, such as cultural heritage, food packaging, anti-counterfeiting and security will be the focus of this year Conference.

The event is organized by the Italian Association for Industrial Research (AIRI), the National Research Council (CNR), Istituto Italiano di Tecnologia (IIT) and Veneto Nanotech, with the collaboration of Federchimica (Italian Federation of the chemical industry), Assobiotec (Italian Association for the Development of Biotechnology), Polytechnic of Turin, Aster (Consortium for Innovation and Technology Transfer in Emilia-Romagna), the Italian Trade Agency (ICE).
